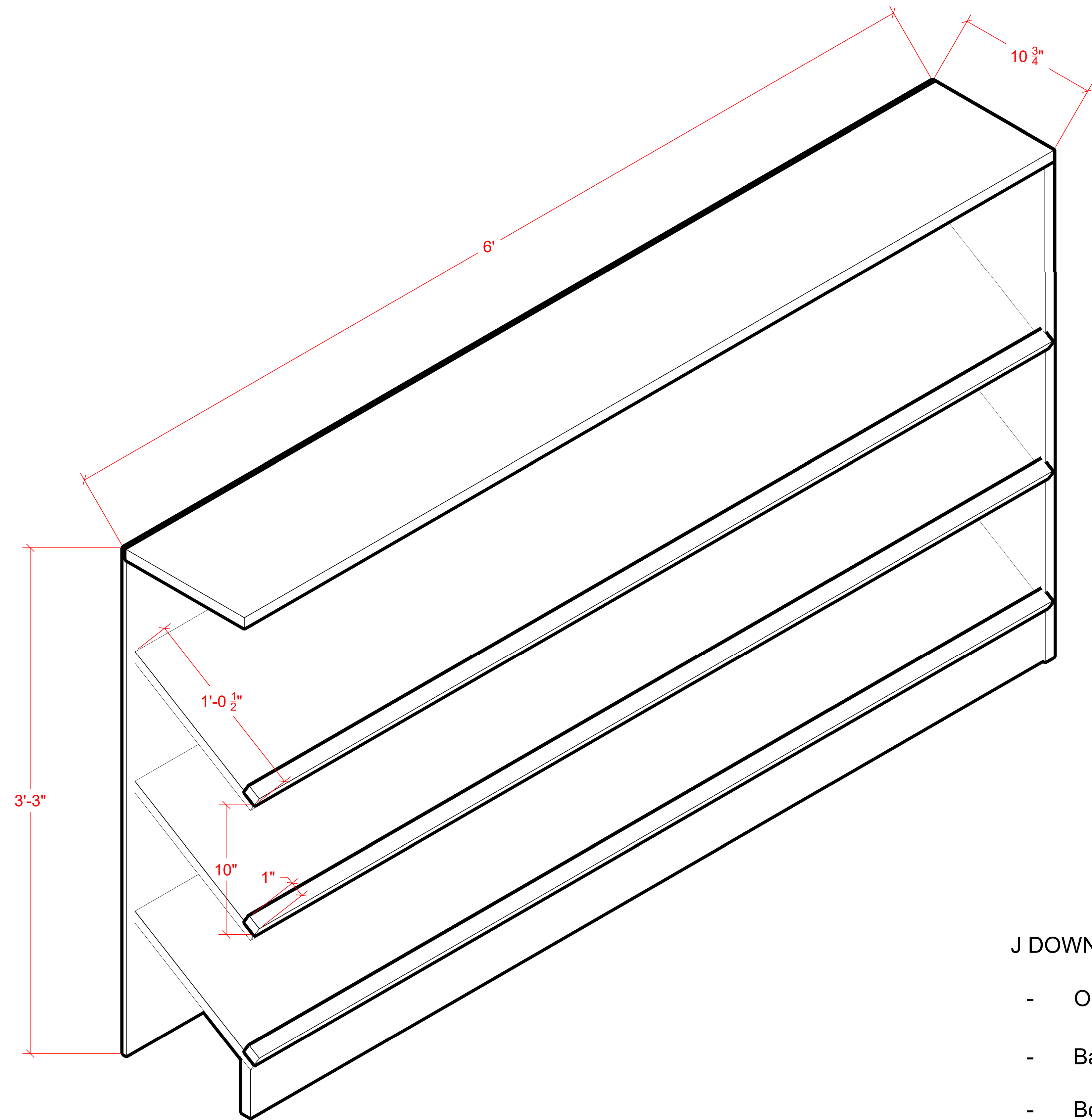

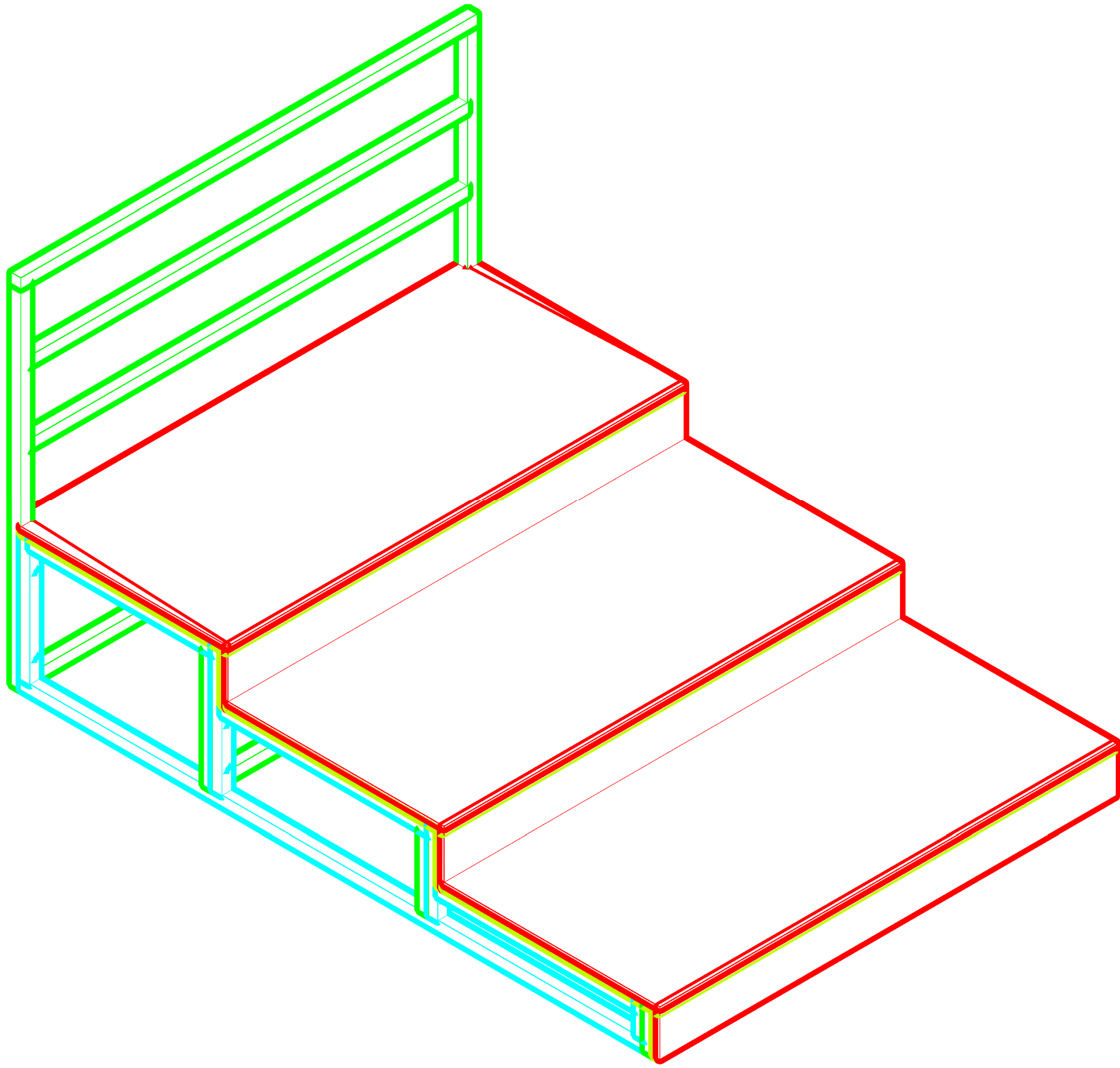

J DOWN SHOE RACK IDEA

- One side removed to show idea better- would be fully enclosed
- Back is currently  $\frac{1}{4}$ " material- could be lauan, could be maso
- Bottom fully enclosed to prevent small items getting kicked underneath
- Angled for ease of placing/grabbing shoes at beginning and end of class
- 10 inches between shelves to avoid squished fingers
- Can hold 21-24 pairs of shoes, width of shoes depending
- The idea is it would fit in that little alcove as you enter J from the lobby, between the railing and the post/cinder brick building support

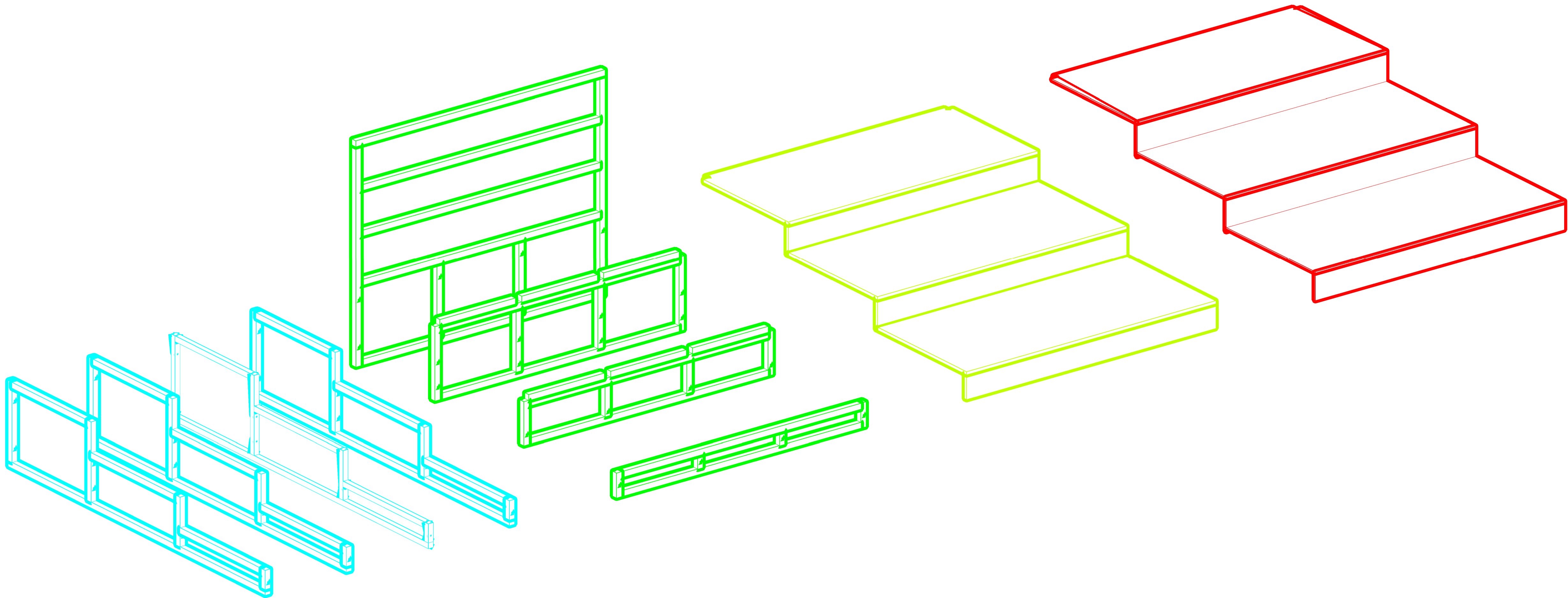
